Criteria for Selection of Scholarship Recipients of Academic Year 2021

1. 2021 Mahidol Postgraduate Scholarships for International Graduate Students

Recipients must:

- (i) Pass the Criteria for Selection of Students for Admission of Academic Year 2021 as a regular student of the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University; and
- (ii) Receive a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.25 on a 4-point grading system or equivalent for undergraduate degree; and
- (iii) Have one of the English Proficiency Test scores that meets the exit requirements based on the Announcement of the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, Subject: English Competence Standards and English Competence Assessment Criteria of Master's Degrees B.E. 2562, i.e., MU GRAD Plus at least 70 (Speaking at least 10 + Writing at least 10); or IELTS at least 5.0 (Speaking at least 5.0 + Writing at least 5.0); or TOEFL iBT at least 64 (Speaking at least 15 + Writing at least 17); or MU ELT at least 84 (Speaking at least 10 + Writing at least 10).

Recipients may be exempted from the above requirement, on a case by case basis, depending upon approval and consent given by the Program Committee. Decision on type and coverage of the scholarship to be awarded to each recipient will be made by the Program Committee based on the aforementioned requirement and any other criteria the Program Committee deems appropriate. Final decision will be approved by the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, based on availability of the scholarship.

2. Partial Scholarship for Thai Graduate Students “ทุนเฉลิมพระเกียรติ 60 ปี ครองราชสมบัติ”

Recipient must:

- (i) Pass the Criteria for Selection of Students for Admission of Academic Year 2021 as a regular student of the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University; and

- (ii) Receive a cumulative grade point average (GPA) of at least 3.25 on a 4-point grading system or equivalent for undergraduate degree; and
- (iii) Have one of the English Proficiency Test scores that meets the exit requirements based on the Announcement of the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, Subject: English Competence Standards and English Competence Assessment Criteria of Master's Degrees B.E. 2562, i.e., MU GRAD Plus at least 70 (Speaking at least 10 + Writing at least 10); or IELTS at least 5.0 (Speaking at least 5.0 + Writing at least 5.0); or TOEFL iBT at least 64 (Speaking at least 15 + Writing at least 17); or MU ELT at least 84 (Speaking at least 10 + Writing at least 10).

Recipients may be exempted from the above requirement, on a case by case basis, depending upon approval and consent given by the Program Committee. Decision on the type of scholarship to be awarded to each recipient will be made by the Program Committee based on the aforementioned requirement and any other criteria the Program Committee deems appropriate. Final decision will be approved by the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, based on availability of the scholarship.

3. Outstanding Academic Performance Scholarship of the Food Science for Nutrition Program

Recipient must:

- (i) Be Thai student of the Program who received the highest GPA of at least 3.50 for his/her 1st year of study in Academic Year 2020; and
- (ii) Not the recipient of Partial Scholarship for Thai Graduate Students “ทุนเฉลิมพระเกียรติ 60 ปี ครองราชสมบัติ” Type 1; and
- (iv) Have one of the English Proficiency Test scores that meets the exit requirements based on the Announcement of the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, Subject: English Competence Standards and English Competence Assessment Criteria of Master's Degrees B.E. 2562, i.e., MU GRAD Plus at least 70 (Speaking at least 10 + Writing at least 10); or IELTS at least 5.0 (Speaking at least 5.0 + Writing at least 5.0); or TOEFL iBT at least 64 (Speaking at least 15 + Writing at least 17); or MU ELT at least 84 (Speaking at least 10 + Writing at least 10).

Recipients may be exempted from the above requirement, on a case-by-case basis, depending upon approval and consent given by the Program Committee. The judgement and decision made by the Program Committee is final.
