Criteria for Selection of Students for Admission of Academic Year 2021

Criteria for the selection of both Thai and international students are based on the scores of English proficiency test and of the entrance examination, as follow:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - MU GRAD Plus at least 70 (Speaking at least 10 + Writing at least 10); or - IELTS at least 5.0 (Speaking at least 5.0 + Writing at least 5.0); or - TOEFL iBT at least 64 (Speaking at least 15 + Writing at least 17); or - MU ELT at least 84 (Speaking at least 10 + Writing at least 10) 	A regular student
Not available or does not meet criteria for regular student	<p>A provisional student</p> <p>The student will be advanced to regular status when submit, within 2 semesters, score of English proficiency test that meets the requirements based on the Announcement of the Faculty of Graduate Studies, Mahidol University, Subject:</p>

Written examination (Specific Knowledge in Food Science and Nutrition)	
Score of lower than 45	Not be accepted as a student of the Program
Score of 45 – 49	A provisional student The student will be advanced to regular status when the grades for all courses in the first semester are at least “B”.
Score at 50 or above	A regular student
Interview examination	
“Poor” rating by majority of the Interview Examination Committee	Not be accepted as a student of the Program
“Satisfactory” rating or better rating by majority of the Interview Examination Committee	A regular or provisional student (depends on the written examination score)
